Have you been wondering how you can help with the 50th reunion? We have several projects that no matter where you live, you can help.

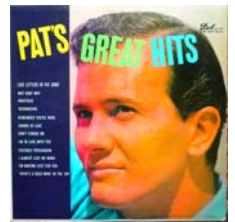
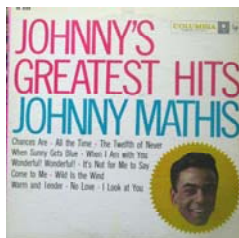
