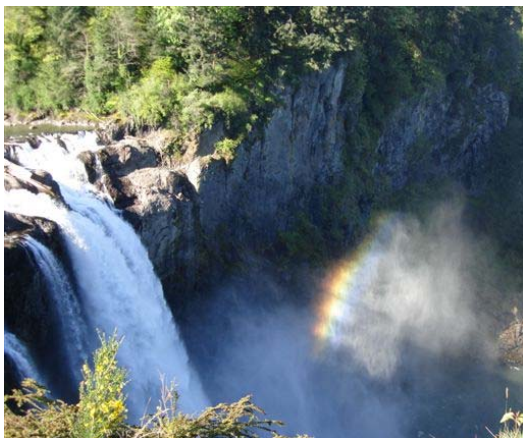
We also spent some extra time in Seattle where we went to the Seattle Museum of Flight.
