This is the Cessna C-162 Sky Catcher that I will be flying on December 1st when I take my first flying lesson at The Orlando Executive Airport. Can't wait !!

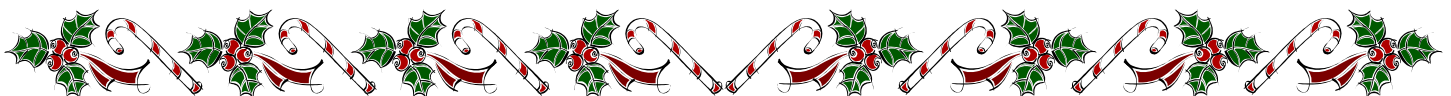
